

Flag Assembly Instructions & Flag Care Tips

Instructions for Flag Assembly

To attach the flags to the poles you can use either a staple gun or flexible adhesive.

Flexible adhesive suggestions include:

- 3M Scotch All Purpose Adhesive – Super Strength
- Contact Cement
- E 6000 Industrial Strength
- Gorilla Glue

Flexible Adhesive Instructions

1. Slip flag on pole and pull down approximately 12 inches from top.
2. Starting near the top put three small drops of flexible adhesive in a line down the pole, approximately three inches apart.
3. Pull flag up to its proper position.
4. Firmly press flag to pole.
5. Roll flag tightly around pole and secure with rubber bands.
6. For the most secure bonding let adhesive dry for 12 – 24 hours.

Tips for Responsible Flag Care

1. Flags should be stored dry and rolled around pole. Secure with rubber bands.
2. ***Do not fold the flags*** – folding decreases the life of the flag.
3. Flags should be carried over the shoulder, military style. ***Never*** drag the flag or pole on the pavement or use as a walking stick, sword, or anything other than its intended purpose. The rubber tip can only go so far in protecting the pole.
4. Flags should not be scrunched or handled roughly. Creases will affect the life of the printing.
5. Flags should be kept clean. Wipe with a weak solution of water and mild dish-washing liquid. ***Dry completely*** before rolling and storing.
